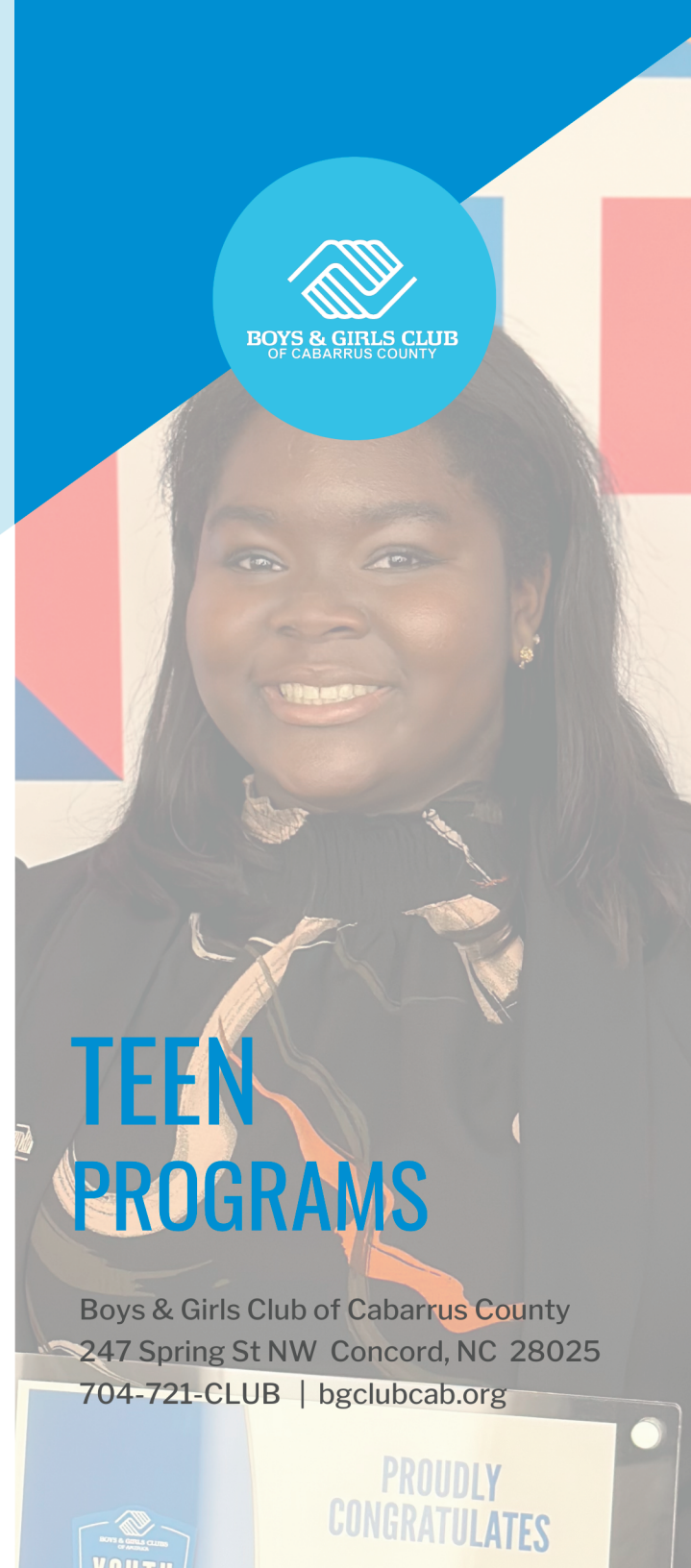

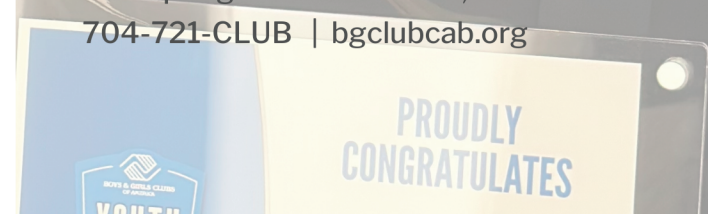

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Our Teen program is for students in grades 9-12 and operates in the same way our Afterschool Program operates.

Transportation is provided from school to the Club from Central Cabarrus High School, Concord High School, Northwest Cabarrus High School and West Cabarrus High School. Students from other high schools may attend, but transportation is not provided.

High School Afterschool Program members have the option of joining the Keystone Club, which will involve participation in community service projects, special events, and volunteering inside and outside the Club.

High school students may enroll in the High School Afterschool Program without being required to participate in the Keystone Club. All members will enjoy the benefits of the High School Afterschool Program and the Teen Center.

TEEN AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM

- The Afterschool Program operates weekdays during the school year from 2:30pm - 7:00pm.
- The Club is open on designated School Closing Days from 7:30am - 7:00pm. School Closing Days are included as part of the Afterschool Program.
- Afternoon snack/dinner is provided at no additional cost.
- Only current registered program members are allowed inside the Teen Center.

THE TEEN CENTER

High School students have access to the Teen Center that includes a pool table and game area, multiple gaming stations, a large screen for television and videos, general gathering area, computer stations and designated study rooms.

THE KEYSTONE CLUB

- The Keystone Club is a Boys & Girls Clubs of America teen program. Its focus is to provide teens an opportunity to gain valuable leadership and service experience. Teens conduct activities in four areas: academic success, career exploration, community service, and teen outreach.
- To enroll in the Keystone Club, the student must first be enrolled as a Teen Afterschool Program Member.
- Keystone Club members must attend weekly meetings which are held on a designated weekday evening. They will also be required to complete a set amount of volunteer hours through community service projects, participating in special events, and volunteering inside and outside the Club.
- High School Afterschool Program members who wish to also participate in the Keystone Club may do so with no additional fee.
- High school students can enroll in the High School Afterschool Program without being required to participate in the Keystone Club.
